



DAL DANCE COLLECTIVE STUDIO POLICIES 2026-2027

ATTENDANCE/ABSENCES:

- Dancers are expected to attend class on a regular basis.
- If a student will be absent, the absence should be reported in the parent portal prior to class time.
- Absences do not allow you to prorate tuition and are not credited to any other month for any reason.
- Students must arrive on time. When students are late it is a disruption to the whole class.
- The studio is not responsible for students before or after classes, so please supervise them until they enter class. Students that are dropped off early or picked up late will incur a babysitting fee of \$15/15 minutes.
- Make-up classes are permitted due to student absences, with students eligible for up to two make-up classes pre winter break and two make-up classes post winter break. Make-up classes must be complete one month prior to our last day of classes as no make-ups are allowed leading up to the recital. All make-up classes must be completed while the student is still enrolled.

DRESS CODE

- All students must adhere to the dress code in order to participate in class.

LEVELS:

- Student placements are at the discretion of the director and teacher. Students progress mentally and physically at different rates. The main objective is that they learn in a safe and correct manner.

HOLIDAYS/CLOSINGS

- The studio may or may not be closed when Loudoun County Public Schools are closed for holidays. Please consult the calendar for holiday closings.
- All holidays on the schedule are built into our schedule and are not eligible for make-ups.
- The studio may or may not be closed when Loudoun County Public Schools are closed for inclement weather. We will send an email at least one hour before class is scheduled if class is cancelled. One or two-hour delays will not change the class schedule for that day.
- Each class has one snow/weather day built into the schedule. If a class has more than one snow day, dancers can schedule a make-up class.

MEDIA

- Students give their permission to DAL Dance Collective to use their photographs and or videos in connection with social media, advertising, television, website, and news coverage of our studio.
- Classes may be recorded for sharing with other students that are unable to attend class due to illness, or for dancers to practice at home.

RECITAL

- The annual recital will be in late May/early June. Classes are pre-assigned to a recital before the school year begins.
- All classes except Tumbling, Turns & Leaps and select advanced classes will be in the annual recital. Teams will also be in recital.
- Our annual recital is an integral part of all classes that participate in the recital. This is why all students are automatically registered for the recital when they register for a recital class. Our pricing for recital classes is all inclusive of tuition, costume, and recital performance fees.
- Tights and shoes are not included in tuition. Students will need to make sure they have the correct tights and shoes for their recital.
- There will be an option to purchase additional items if you choose such as recital t-shirts, recital flowers, additional tickets, etc.

MEMBERSHIP FEE

- Every student will have a \$35 annual membership fee due at time of registration.
- Families will receive priority registration for both summer 2027 and school year 2027-2028.
- Families will receive priority tickets for Nutcracker.



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REGISTRATION & ENROLLMENT:

- Enrollment for the 2026-2027 school year begins May 21st, 2026 for currently enrolled students. Enrollments for the 2026-2027 school year begins June 1st for new students.
- You are enrolling for the full length of our school year (September 8th through May 27th plus the recital for classes that participate). See below for our withdrawal policy.
- Enrollment must be completed through our online registration system.
- Enrollment is ongoing as long as a class still has open spaces available. After January 1st, class availability will be based upon costume availability. All classes will close for enrollment no later than March 1st.
- We reserve the right to cancel a class at any time. We also reserve the right to change our schedule as needed. If your class is cancelled or moved, we will offer you the choice of choosing a new class or a refund for any classes that have been paid for and have not occurred.
- After October 15th, there is a \$25 fee for changing classes. After January 1st, recital class changes will incur a \$100 change fee and will be dependent on costume availability.

WITHDRAWALS

- Once enrolled you are expected to pay all payments unless you withdraw via our official withdrawal form 30 days before the next tuition is due.
- You may withdraw by filling out the official withdrawal form. Withdrawal via email message or phone will not be accepted.

TUITION

- The annual membership fee (\$35/student) and the first payment (equal to two installments) are due at registration to hold your space in the class. Tuition will automatically be charged on the 15th of each month (October Through May) unless a withdrawal form is received 30 days prior to the tuition due date.
- Each student's first class is the standard tuition – each additional class is 20% off. All classes must be taken by the same student to receive the discount.
- All tuition is set up on automatic credit card payments or automatic ach payments.
- Tuition not paid within 10 days of the original due date will accrue a \$25 late fee.
- Students with tuition more than 30 days behind will be unenrolled from classes.
- 2026-2027 school year tuition is refundable minus the \$35 membership fee if withdrawn prior to August 1, 2026. **After August 1, 2026, there are no refunds.** This includes but is not limited to tuition, recital fees, costume fees, competition fees, performance fees and team fees. We do not offer refunds for any reason including but not limited to medical reasons, natural or national disasters and/or emergencies that cause us to shut down for any reason. If we shut down due to natural or national disasters and/or emergencies, classes will move to an online platform to finish that month's payment. The next tuition can be suspended or applied towards a continuing online class structure.

GENERAL STUDIO POLICIES

- Please drive slowly and carefully through the parking lot at all times. Always arrive early to allow time to find parking. Some days during peak times, parking near the front of the studio may be full and you may need to park further away and walk.
- All food and drink besides water must be consumed in our cafe area of our Leesburg studio.
- Parents and siblings are welcome to wait in the lobby during your dancer's classes. However the noise level must remain at a comfortable level and running will not be allowed. Siblings must be supervised at all times.
- Rooms 1 and 6 in Leesburg and our Purcellville studio have a viewing window for parents to watch class through. For rooms 2, 3, 4 and 5 in Leesburg, there is a tv in the lobby with a live feed of those classes for parents to watch. Only dancers are allowed in the back areas of the studio by rooms 2, 3, 4 and 5 for our students' safety.
- Pets are not allowed in the studio.

The studio reserves the right to modify and/or add to our policies at any time.

WHAT'S INCLUDED?

- **Tuition:** Full school year of dance classes broken down into 10 installments. The first two installments are due at registration. The additional 8 installments are due on the 15th of each month from October-May.
- **Recital Fees:** Seamless participation in our annual recital, with all associated costs covered in your tuition. Recital fees include participation in recital and dress rehearsal, 2 tickets per dancer which are good for all shows, the school rentals for shows and rehearsals, recital medal for each dancer, and a professional video download of all recital shows, as well as covering our staff and instructors' time they spend planning and in attendance at dress rehearsals and recital.
- **Costumes:** Your tuition includes the cost of your costume required for our annual recital, making preparation for our recital hassle-free.

RECITAL CLASS TUITION:

Our annual recital is an integral part of all classes that participate in the recital. This is why all students are automatically registered for the recital when they register for a recital class.
